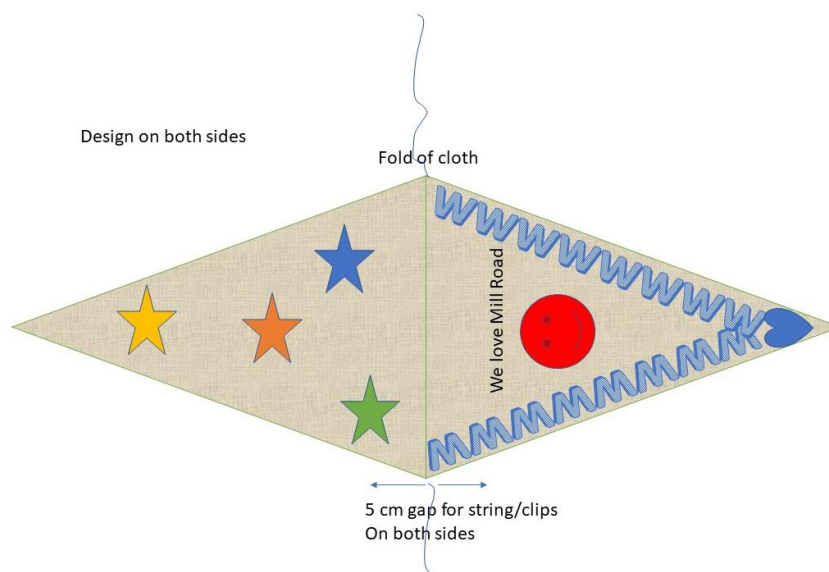
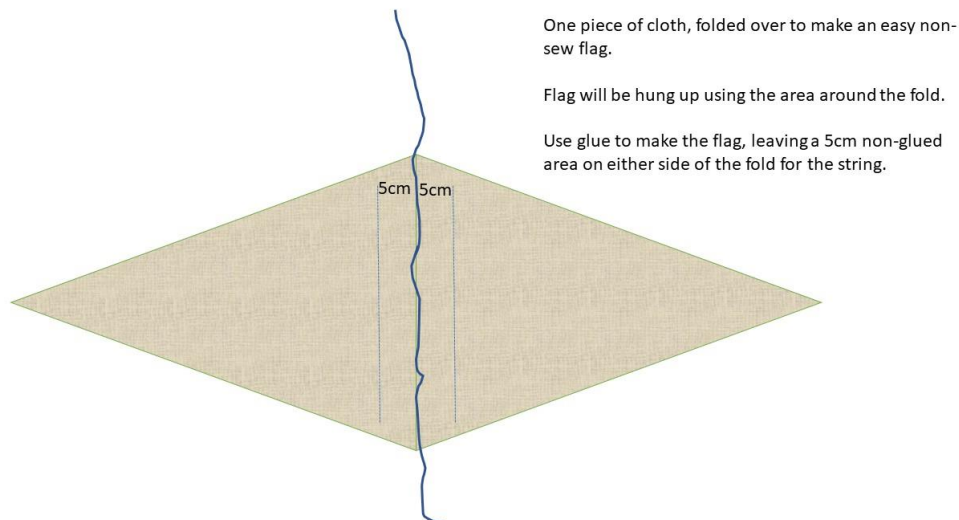


## Make Bunting for the Mill Road Saturdays

Mill Road Fringe would like to decorate three new Mill Road events called *Mill Road Saturdays* with community-made bunting. Help us make **200 bunting flags** by **1<sup>st</sup> September 2021** inspired by our theme: **“Your Life in and Around Mill Road”**. Making a bunting flag is easy, so everyone can get involved!

1. Choose one of the template designs.
2. Choose a durable fabric as the base material for your flag.
3. Cut out your shape from the fabric. Make sure that you add some room at the top so that it can be hung up (about 5cm). Your flag will need to be decorated on both sides – if you are using a thinner fabric, an easy no-sew way is to cut out two template shapes end-to-end and then fold the fabric at the top:

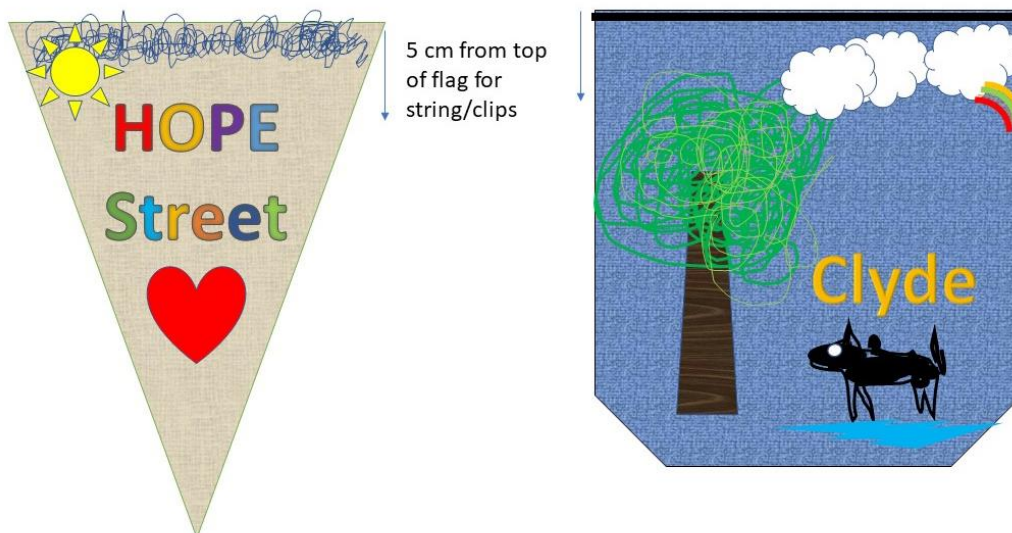


4. Decorate your flag as you wish, on both sides.

Recycled materials and resources can be obtained from many shops along Mill Road.

### Some tips

- Measurements shown on the templates are approximate.
- Make sure your flags have designs on both sides.
- Flags can be as unique as you want – the more diverse and colourful, the better.
- To decorate your flags, you can use buttons, ribbons, other material scraps, glitter, photos, recycling, fabric pens, Lego, Hama beads... any odds and ends.
- You don't need to sew – you can use glue, staples, weaving... anything goes!
- The flags will be outside in all weathers, so make them durable. Durable fabrics include canvas, oilskin tablecloths, curtain fabric, heavy tablecloth, leather, etc.
- You can make as many bunting flags as you want.
